- **ASSIST** in planning and coordinating special events such as Vacation Bible School, family retreats, social outings, and holiday celebrations.
- **COMMUNICATE**: Keep Session informed and involved in the outreach process with regularly scheduled written reports on the outreach ministry.
- **MAINTAIN** a safe and welcoming environment for students and families embracing and celebrating the generational diversity of our congregation. Adhere to all state, local, and FPC Branson child protection policies and procedures.

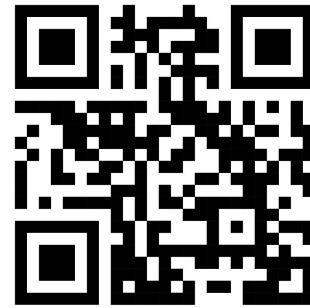
QUALIFICATIONS
